#### 2. About the Rayat Shikshan Sanstha, Satara:

The Rayat Shikshan Sanstha, founded by Late Padmabhushan Dr. Karmaveer Bhaurao Patil in 1919, is one of the leading and largest educational institutions in Asia. Its main objective is to provide education to the downtrodden, the poor and the ignorant, which is the major bulk of society, irrespective of caste, creed and religion with a motto "Education through Self-Help" to inculcate the dignity of labour among the students along with the social, spiritual, cultural and human values. Karmaveer Bhaurao Patil was visionary and realized the dire need of education who devoted his life to the cause of education of masses. He believed in education as a means to eradicate the social ills such as illiteracy, untouchability, caste hierarchy, money lending, superstitions, social and economic inequality, all his life, he tried to translate this belief into reality.

Rayat Shikshan Sanstha, since its establishment, started 739 institutions including schools, junior and senior colleges usually in remote, rural and tribal areas for the education of downtrodden and children deprived of education, which was neglected by the then educationists.

#### 3. About the College:

Shri Sadguru Gangageer Maharaj Science, Gautam Arts and Sanjivani Commerce College is one of the 42 senior colleges established by Rayat Shikshan Sanstha in 1965. On 1<sup>st</sup> June 1965 Karmaveer Shankarrao Kale and Sakhar Maharshi Shankarrao Kolhe, along with few others laid the foundation stone of the college. With its affiliation to the Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune college started functioning just with 34 students on roll with science faculty and is now grown like a banyan tree. The college is recognized under section 2(f) on 10<sup>th</sup> July 1989 by UGC and with a Grant-in-aid by Government of Maharashtra. The college aims at training students from weaker sections of the society to be leaders in all walks of life and serve the society.

The beneficiaries are from socio-economically backward classes, poor farmers' children, and labour family children. The college is sponsored by Department of Science and Technology (DST) under FIST program in 2006 and 2014. The affiliating university has awarded us with a "Best College Award" for the year 2007. Our parent institute has also awarded our college with various awards. College is accredited with A++ grade in 4<sup>th</sup> cycle. The college runs 16 UG (Arts, Commerce, Science, Management and Computer Science), 11 PG and 02 Research Programs. It serves multi-dimensionally in the field of higher education.

The college is working and functioning with the same vision and mission statements as of parent institute.

The institution is spread over 22.5 acres of lush green land.

Along with Arts, Science and Commerce, we impart education of MCVC in Electrical, Electronic and Construction Technology. Through Science stream we have Bi-focal Electronics as an optional subject which caters career options in Architecture and Bio-Tech Agriculture. #### 6. Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC)

**Establishment of IQAC**: 30/06/2004

#### **\*** Introduction:

In pursuance of its action plan for performance evaluation, assessment and accreditation and quality up-gradation of institutions of higher education, the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) proposes that accredited institution should establish an Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) as a post-accreditation quality sustenance measure. Since quality enhancement is a continuous process, the IQAC will become a part of the institution's system and work towards the realization of the goals of quality enhancement and sustenance. The prime task of the IQAC is to develop a system for conscious, consistent and catalytic improvement in the overall performance of institutions. For this, during the post-accreditation period, it will channelize all efforts and measures of the institution towards promoting its holistic academic excellence.

The work of the IQAC is the first step towards internalization and institutionalization of quality enhancement initiatives. Its success depends on the sense of belongingness and participation it can inculcate in all the constituents of the institution. It will be a facilitative and participative voluntary unit of the institution. It has the potential to become a vehicle for ushering in quality enhancement by working out planned interventionist strategies to remove deficiencies and enhance quality.

#### **Objectives:**

- > To develop a system for conscious, consistent and catalytic action to improve the academic and administrative performance of the institution.
- > To promote measures for institutional functioning towards quality enhancement through the internalization of quality culture and institutionalization of best practices.

- > The credibility of evaluation procedures;
- Ensuring the adequacy, maintenance and proper allocation of support structure and services;
- > Sharing of research findings and networking with other institutions in India and abroad.

#### **\*** Functions:

- > Development and application of quality benchmarks/parameters for various academic and administrative activities of the institution;
- Facilitating the creation of a learner-centric environment conducive to quality education and faculty maturation to adopt the required knowledge and technology for participatory teaching and learning process;
- Arrangement for feedback response from students, parents and other stakeholders on quality-related institutional processes;
- Dissemination of information on various quality parameters of higher education;

- Organization of inter and intra-institutional workshops, seminars on quality related themes and promotion of quality circles;
- Documentation of the various programmes/activities leading to quality improvement;
- Acting as a nodal agency of the Institution for coordinating quality-related activities, including adoption and dissemination of best practices;
- > Development and maintenance of institutional database through MIS for the purpose of maintaining /enhancing the institutional quality;
- Development of Quality Culture in the institution;
- ➤ Preparation of the Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) as per guidelines and parameters of NAAC, to be submitted to NAAC.

#### **Benefits:**

- Ensure heightened level of clarity and focus in institutional functioning towards quality enhancement;
- Ensure internalization of the quality culture;
- Ensure enhancement and coordination among various activities of the institution and institutionalize all good practices;
- Provide a sound basis for decision-making to improve institutional functioning;
- Act as a dynamic system for quality changes in HEIs;
- > Build an organized methodology of documentation and internal communication.

#### 7. National Education Policy 2020:

Highlighting the importance of flexible learning, National Education Policy 2020 states that imaginative and flexible curricular structures will enable creative combinations of disciplines for study and would offer multiple entry and multiple exit (MEME) options and thus, remove the currently prevalent rigid boundaries. These would create new opportunities for students to choose and learn the subjects of their choice while changing the HEIs as per their preference, convenience or necessity. In order to pave the way for seamless student mobility, the NEP 2020 envisages adjustments in the structures and lengths of degree programmes. Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) ensures seamless student mobility between or within degree-granting HEIs through a formal system of credit recognition, credit accumulation, credit transfers, and credit redemption to promote distributed and flexible teaching-learning. To take this forward, NEP 2020 promotes rigorous research-based specializations and opportunities for multidisciplinary education, at the Graduate, Master's and Doctoral level programmes in HEIs.

To reach to the design of holistic and multidisciplinary programmes as anticipated in NEP 2020, HEls require some time to streamline it in higher education in India. As stated above, as per their universities and colleges preference, convenience or necessity, ideal multidisciplinary programmes may come into existence in future. However, existing undergraduate porgrammes may be converted into a new framework having multiple entries and multiple exit options and with additions of Skill Enhancement Courses in credit system. The continuous comprehensive evaluation is also a requirement for proper mapping of learning outcomes, course outcomes and programme outcomes as our system is based on principles of outcome based education. Hence, the university will continue its choice based credit system for quality based evaluation porgrammes. In the light of NEP 2020, HEls can provide the courses as per tune preference, convenience or necessity for the students.

#### 1) Title:

The Regulations Governing the Choice Based Credit System with Multiple Entry and Multiple Exit Option.

#### 2) Scope:

These regulations are applicable to the undergraduate and Post Graduate Degree Programmes being offered in affiliated colleges, excluding autonomous colleges / instituted and in university departments.

#### 3) Commencement:

These Regulations in accordance with National Education Policy 2020 shall come from this Academic Year onwards. These regulations shall be implemented from academic year.

#### 4) NEP Implementation in First Phase:

The credit and curricular framework is to be made applicable, in the first phase, to the following programmes (other than those regulated by AICTE, PCI, BCI, CoA, NCTE etc.) with effect from this Academic Year: **UG:** B.A., B.Sc., B.Com., BBA, B.Sc. (CS) and all Non-AICTE Professional UG Degree Programs. **PG:** M.A., M.Sc., M.Com. and all Non-AICTE Professional PG Degree Programs.

# 5) Credit Framework under Three / Four Years UG Programmes with Multiple Entry and Multiple Exit options:

The structure of the Three / Four year bachelor's degree porgramme allows the opportunity to the students to experience the full range of holistic and multidisciplinary education in addition to a focus on the chosen major and minors as per their choices and the feasibility of exploring learning in different institutions. The minimum and maximum credit structure for different levels under the Three / Four year UG Programme with multiple entry and multiple exit options are as given below:

#### 16. Discipline & Code of Conduct:

#### **■** Discipline:

- 1 Self discipline is the best discipline. All the students are expected to observe rules and regulations currently in force to enable smooth working of the college.
- 2. Students are prohibited from doing anything inside or outside the college premises that will interfere with its orderly administration or affect its public image. No outside influence, political or any other should be brought into the college, directly or indirectly.
- 3. Students resorting to unfair means at the exams will be dealt with in accordance with the provisions of the Government of Maharashtra Act No. XXXI of 1982 and the Maharashtra Universities Act. 1994.

#### **■** Code of Conduct:

- 1. Students should always carry their valid college **Identity Card** whenever in college or representing the college at other places. Further it should be produced whenever demanded by any of the college staff.
- 2. During the conduct of lectures students should not loiter in and around the college premises.
- 3. The college does not enforce any dress code. However, all students' are expected to observe decorum with regard to both clothing and behavior.
- 4. Total College Campus is under CCTV Surveillance.
- 5. In case of any problem (personal or academic) students should report to the Vice Principal of their respective faculty.
- 6. Students are directed not to bring any outsider to the college premises.
- 7. Students should not collect any funds from other students or from outsiders without the written permission of the Principal.
- 8. Students shall not organize picnics, excursions, and trips etc. on their own without prior written permission of the Principal.
- 9. The powers relating to the disciplinary action in the college will rest with the Principal and his decision in this respect shall be final and binding. Anyone who violates the code of conduct will be severely dealt with.
- 10. The act of taking 'Common Off' will be treated as a cognizable offence.
- 11. Students should be cautious about not causing any damage to the college property. Any such attempt will be severely punished.

- 12. Every Student of the college should appear for the all examinations conducted by the college.
- 13. As per the directives of the Rayat Shikshan Sanstha, Satara, there shall be no Annual Social Gathering and Celebration of any traditional day in the college.
- 14. While representing the college at any other place the students' behavior should not be detrimental to the image of the college.

#### ■ The Use of Tobacco Prohibited:

The use of tobacco in any form (i.e. tobacco - chewing, Gutkha chewing, alcoholic drink or smoking) in the college premises is strictly prohibited.

#### ■ Ragging Prohibited:

The Government of Maharashtra has notified Ragging as a cognizable offence. Anyone reported to be involved in any form of ragging will be severely dealt with. Legal action will be taken against anyone as per Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act 1999. Therefore, students are advised to refrain from indulging in any form of ragging.

#### ■ Prevention of Sexual Harassment/ICC Committee:

The college will not tolerate sexual harassment of female / male candidates in the college premises. Legal action will be taken against anyone involved in the sexual harassment as per **Maharashtra University act 1954, Savitribai Phule Pune University and Grievance Cell.** There is Internal Complaint Committee and 'Nirbandha Pathak' in the college.

#### ■ Counseling and Grievance Redressal Cell:

It has been observed that some of the students have personal problems, causing stress and strain. The college has set up a Counseling Cell to help such students to cope with these problems. The students/parents are requested to make use of this facility. All personal matters in this regard will be kept confidential. Students are advised to contact Vice-Principal or Head of Departments in this regard.

#### 17. What Constitutes Ragging:

#### ■ Ragging constitutes one or more of any of the following acts:

- 1. Any conduct by any student whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student.
- 2. Indulging in rowdy or indiscipline activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student.
- 3. Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student.
- 4. Any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher.
- 5. Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students.

- 6. Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students.
- 7. Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person.
- 8. Any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, post, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student.

#### 19. Library Facilities:

Besides, the Library provides Scopus Index, UGC Care List and Peer reviewed 23 e-journals through 'ezy Access by Apex Subs. Pvt. Ltd. Agency on <a href="https://www.ezyaccess.in">www.ezyaccess.in</a> to all the members of the faculties as well as students.

#### General Rules:

- 1. Every student must have a valid college Identity Card in the premises of the library. It should be produced as and when demanded by any of the Library staff.
- 2. Identity Card and Borrower's Card are non-transferable.
- 3. Students must handle the books or periodicals etc. with great care. Any attempt to damage books or periodicals by defacing them or tearing the pages off, shall be treated as misconduct and be strictly dealt with.
- 4. If the original borrower-card is lost, a duplicate borrower-card will be issued on payment of rupees 20/only.

#### Rules for the Study-Room:

- 1. Complete silence and strict discipline be maintained in the library and study-room.
- 2. Text Books, Reference Books and Journals will be issued to students against I-cards. Students are not allowed to take them outside the study-room.
- 3. If any particular reference is required, students should approach the Librarian.

#### **Home-issue (Book Circulation):**

- 1. Every student is expected to read and strictly follow the Instructions given on the reverse side of the Borrower's Card.
- 2. Each student will be issued two books at a time for one week only, a fine of one rupee per day will be charged in case of late returns.

In accordance with the Circular Number SWC215/93 dated 21<sup>st</sup> May 1993 from Students Welfare Committee of Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune the Said Insurance Scheme has been started.

Accordingly the student avails of insurance from United India Insurance Company on paying insurance premium at confessional rates.

The students or his/her nominee receives compensation as against his/her accidental date or permanent disablement or loss of limb or casualty during the current academic year. The students or his nominee will have to submit Personal Accident Insurance Claim Form duly filled in order to claim compensation. In case of accidental death following documents should be submitted along with the claim form duly completed.

- 1. First Information Report
- 2. Police Panchanama
- 3. Post mortem Report
- 4. Certificate of Death

In case of permanent injury following documents should be submitted together with the claim form.

- 1. Certificate of the doctor
- 2. Relevant prescription bills, receipts etc

The duly completed form should be submitted within 10 days of the accident. The student is liable to receive a maximum of Rs. 10000/- (Rs. Ten thousand only) in compensation in case of oblivious accidental death and a minimum sum of Rs. 500/- (Rs. Five hundred only) in case of disablement. The insurance company does not admit liability and accommodate claim unless essential relevant documents are produced.
